Payments for all commercial vessels should be made at the Dues Counter, Top Floor, King Road Avenue Entrance, St. Andrew's House. Private pleasure craft owners may also pay at the Haven Master's Office.

Value Added Tax, where applicable, will be applied to the rates quoted in this schedule.

All goods and services are handled subject to the Port Company's Byelaws, regulations, conditions and credit terms.

Extract from Vessel Dues Schedule relevant to the Bristol Port Company's Mandatory Waste Management Charge:

g) **MERCHANT SHIPPING AND FISHING VESSELS (Port Waste reception Facilities) REGULATIONS 2003**

The mandatory charge for handling galley waste and general garbage at The Bristol Port Company is:-

First skip	=£28.00*
Second and subsequent skips	=£56.00 each

* The mandatory charge is in total £56.00 per vessel, a £28.00 proportion of which is already included within the Port's consolidated handling charges or scheduled Vessel Dues. This total charge covers all of the costs incurred in providing the first garbage skip per vessel.

NB:-

1. The Bristol Port Company is required under the above regulations to apply a charge to all ships visiting the Port for the provision of reception facilities for ship-generated waste.
2. Further skips are available on request and will be charged as above. Additional skips should be ordered via the Marine Department.
3. Other ship-generated waste material i.e. waste oil, slops, sewage, cargo dunnage, large plastic sheets etc should be disposed of, as now, by the individual ship's agent using approved waste contractors.
